

TWO ANGELS PINOT NOIR 2013

Description:

The 2013 Two Angels Pinot Noir exhibits stunning purple-garnet hues and exudes aromas of red berries, some spice, and hints of fresh forest floor after a rain. Abundant flavors this well-structured is incredibly balanced and drinkable now and with great aging potential for the next 10+ years.

Winemaker's Notes:

The 2013 vintage of Carneros Pinot Noir will be one of the best vintages in the last 10 - 15 years. Mild climate and dry late summer through fall has produced wines with good color, extract and ample fruit. The wine was fermented in stainless steel, and sur lie aged for aged 10 months in 25% new French oak.

Interesting Fact:

The label art was created by Jacob de Backer in 1591. The theme of the piece is the hilarity of inebriation and the trauma of the morning after. Excessive joy must be countered by equally excessive sorrow, with penitential atonement for pleasure (the first "Drink Responsibly" print campaign).

Serving Hints:

Serve at room temperature with steaks and other grilled meats, roasts and hearty fare.
