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2020

- 93 – JAMES SUCKLING, *February 2025*

"Notes of dark cherries and plums with dark spices, chocolate and hints of moist bark. Medium- to full-bodied with ripe and concentrated fruit and velvety tannins. Chalky and a little earthy at the end. Try after 2026."

2019

- 93 – JAMES SUCKLING, *November 2023*

"This is spiced and earthy on the nose, offering notes of dried cherries and strawberries together with dark licorice and bark undertones. Medium- to full-bodied, dense and structured with firm chewy tannins. Layered and broad. Long. Try after 2027."

2018

- 92 – WINE ENTHUSIAST, *October 1, 2022*

"Aromas of mocha, smoke and ripe black-skinned berry take shape in the glass. The firmly structured palate dried black cherry, clove and tobacco alongside fine-grained tannins. Drink 2023-2030."

- 92 – WINE ADVOCATE, *December 15, 2022*

"The Bel Colle 2018 Barolo Bussia shows ripeness on the bouquet with dried cherry and raspberry tart, but the wine is also redolent of garden herb and crushed flowers. This expression from Bussia is very silky and smooth with a polished, medium-weight finish. Earthy sensations appear, and you get hints of rust or iron ore."
