"This has a spicy, perfumed nose of dark fruit, pine cones, licorice, nutmeg and sandalwood. Olives and grilled meat, too. Medium-to full-bodied with sleek, sinewy tannins. Meaty and spicy palate. Drink or hold."

- 90 – DECANTER, WORLD WINE AWARDS SILVER, *September 23, 2020*

"Fresh mint and cassis aromas along pepper, wild herbs and blackberries. Judicious use of oak, muscular palate, lively and juicy."

- 90 – VINOUS, *October 21, 2020*

"A 60/40 Malbec/Cabernet Sauvignon blend that spent eight months in barrels. Dark purple in color, displaying an attractive aromatic intensity in its spice, dark fruit and plum jam notes. Fleshy on the palate, offering fine, grippy tannins that lend depth to the moderately fresh mouthfeel. Ends with a slightly dusty sensation."

"A very fine-textured red with berries, chocolate and spices. medium body, polished tannins and a savory finish. long and caressing. A blend of malbec and cabernet sauvignon. Drink now."
