"This shows notes of ripe dark cherries, blackcurrants, walnuts, graphite and hints of tobacco. Medium- to full-bodied with polished, nicely crafted tannins and a velvety texture. Seamless and lingering. Drink or hold."

"Richly textured, with plush tannins. Dark red and blue berries feel plump on the palate. The sleek liquid is enhanced by mocha and saddle leather. Cedar and sweet tobacco weave a well-tailored finish."

"Some roasted red chili pepper and olives to the bright cassis and red plum characters on the nose with a hint of dark chocolate, juicy and a tad sweet-and-sour with a medium body, showing some round tannins and berries. Well-balanced and drinkable even though there is not a lot of depth on the center-palate. Open to enjoy now."

"Ripe blackberries, black cherries and plums. Some licorice and spiced oak, too. Full-bodied with a creamy texture and velvety tannins. Well-balanced with notable minerality and a long, fruity finish. Drink or hold."

"Easy richness fills this wine with red-cherry scents, notes of tobacco and charcoal. It's full and ample, ending with a little salty bitterness that would meld with seared duck breast."

"Nice, pure currants and plums with hints of fresh herbs and pine needles. Full-to medium-bodied with very pretty, round tannins that are nicely integrated with the light chocolate and hazelnut flavors that color the lovely fruit at the finish. Drinkable now, but better in a year or two."
