Crunchy and vivid, this offers fresh cherries, pink nectarines and grapefruit peel on the nose. Medium-bodied with crisp acidity, this is flavorful and refreshing. Drink now. Screw cap.

“With a bit more heft than the Provençal style possesses, this blend of 72% Syrah, 18% Merlot, 8% Grenache, and 2% Mourvèdre offers aromas and flavors of red apple and red berries that are highlighted by the charms of watermelon candy and bubblegum on the nose and enhanced by ripe peach on the palate, whose juiciness is underscored by a tart squeeze of lime on the finish.”

“The 2023 Rosé is delicate in the glass with a vivid rose petal and dried strawberry bouquet. It opens with a balanced inner sweetness and perfumed orchard fruits, elevated by hints of candied citrus and ripe melon. The 2023 cleans up beautifully, with medium length and a tactile mineral tinge. This is remarkably pretty.”
