EQ 'Granite' Pinot Noir

"Press Highlights"

2022

- 94 – JAMES SUCKLING, *December 6, 2024*

"Such a lively pinot showing vivid wild strawberries from the forest floor with a fine twist of stems, white pepper and white mushrooms. Medium-bodied, fluid and refined, showing plenty of ethereal fruit. Lengthy finish full of savory herbs and berries. Consistently outstanding and likely one of the best from Casablanca. Drink or hold."

2021

- 93 – JAMES SUCKLING, *February 1, 2023*

"This has aromas of moss, cranberries, watermelon, red tea, crushed stones and citrus zest. Hints of raw walnuts. It's tight, flavorful and focused, with a medium body, chalky tannins and a mineral finish."

2020

- 92 – JAMES SUCKLING, *February 1, 2023*

"This has aromas of sliced oranges, raspberries, red cherries, peaches, cola and cinnamon stick. It's medium-bodied with powdery, almost chalky tannins and crunchy red and orange fruit. So fresh. Drink now."

2019

- 93 – WINE ADVOCATE, *April 6, 2023*

"The 2019 EQ Granite Pinot Noir was produced with grapes from the young Valle Hermoso coastal vineyard that has been worked biodynamically since it was planted (but the wine is only certified organic). It had a traditional vinification with 25% full clusters, a seven-day cold soak and malolactic and 12 months' aging in Burgundian barrels. It has contained ripeness at 13.5% alcohol, an expressive nose of berries and herbs, a note of meat and a juicy palate with a soft texture and soft tannins..."

2018

"A flavorful, savory pinot with ripe dark cherries and raspberries, roasted licorice, coca cola, wet earth and dried roses. A very smooth pinot with fresh but naturally rendered acidity that gives it a supple and composed feel. Long, with lots of roses and forest-berries in the finish. From organically grown grapes with Ecocert certification. A joy to drink now."
