2021

94 – JAMES SUCKLING, March 2024

"This draws you in with milk chocolate, sweet plums, cedar and blueberry pie on the nose, followed by a firm and structured palate. Full-bodied, with compact and firm tannins, and a deep core of blue fruit. Needs a couple of years. Try after 2025."

2020

93 – VINOUS, June 2023

"The 2020 Gran Malbec IV Generación hails from Los Chacayes in the Uco Valley and was aged for 12 months in French oak barrels, 15% of them new. Purple with a garnet sheen. The balsamic nose offers blackberry and mint notes, along with chutney-like nuances over a layer of oak. Taut with a chalky texture on the palate, the polished, reactive tannins dial up the energy during the juicy flow. This is a potent, well-crafted red from a warm year."

2019

"One tremendously exceptional red. Spiced cedar, mulberry, and black tea join garden herbs and violets for an intense, yet juicy, red. Tannins are plush and a dot of white pepper seasons generous blackberry jam notes."

"Dark plums, cherries, dried herbs, tobacco leaves and cigar box on the nose. Full-bodied with ripe, chewy tannins. Generous and plush with dark-fruit and dark-chocolate. Serious and big wine. Long finish. Drink from 2023."

94 – VINOUS, September 2022

"From Los Chacayes, Uco Valley, the 2019 Gran Malbec IV Generación was 100% aged in a third new French barrels. Dark purple in hue. The herbal nose offers notes of ripe plum, hints of blackberry and gentle aromas of violet and vanilla cookie, all within an oaky frame. Free-flowing and broad with finely grained tannins, it has an energetic core that expands to fill up the palate. An intense, intricately subtle wine."

2018

94 – VINOUS. November 2021

"From Los Chacayes, Uco Valley, the 2018 Gran Malbec IV Generación was aged for 12 months in 40% new French barrels. Vivid purple in color. The complex nose presents aromas of thyme and mint with fresh plum and prunes along with hints of violets and aromas from the aging process. In the mouth, it's broad and juicy with a terse feel sculpted by the fine tannins. The freshness enlivens the palate and adds to the depth. The 2018 is a long-lasting, substantial, vigorously voluminous red."
